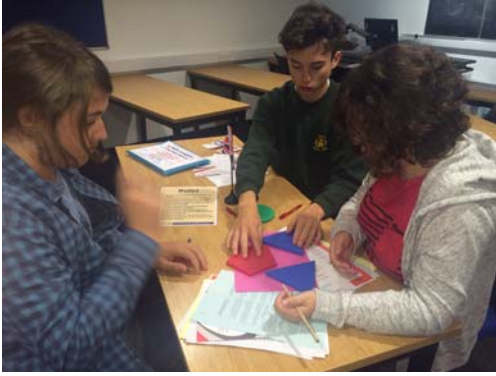

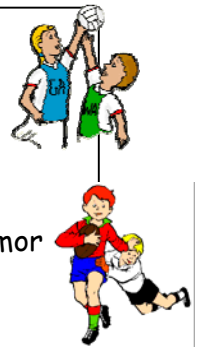
Gweithdy Adfywio Calon

- Peidiwch â chefnogi unrhyw fath o fwlio.

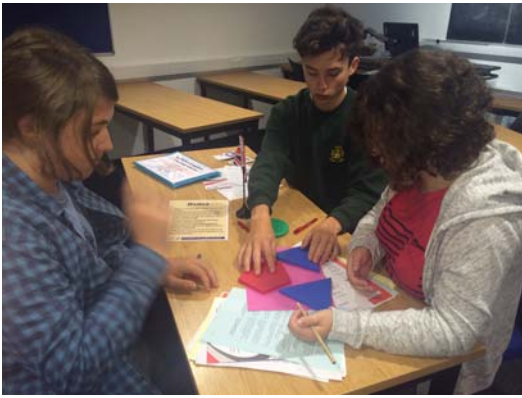
Ysgol Glan y Môr - Anti Bullying Policy



Glan y Môr pupils agree that every pupil has the right to feel totally safe and happy at school. They also agree that nobody should bully or behave in a hurtful manner towards any individual.

These are the guidelines formed by Glan y Môr pupils regarding anti-bullying :

- You should report any incident of bullying and never ignore it.
- You should say if you are being bullied or are unhappy.
- You should support individuals who are lonely / support unhappy individuals.
- You should treat others as you would wish to be treated yourself.
- Never misuse the internet to bully individuals.
- Don't send nasty text messages.
- Don't call anybody nasty names.
- Don't bully individuals because they are different in any way e.g. race, religion, interests, personality, appearance, sexuality.
- Don't promote any fighting between individuals and make every effort to stop it.
- Don't participate in any form of bullying.
